

- 1. Using a vehicle on school property is a privilege granted by the Springfield Catholic High School.
- 2. The driver and the owner of the vehicle accept full responsibility for the vehicle while on campus or at school functions off-campus.
- 3. Springfield Catholic Schools does not accept responsibility for damage to vehicles nor thefts from vehicles, nor thefts of vehicles while on campus or at school functions.
- 4. Students should not bring valuables to school or leave them in their vehicles.
- 5. All vehicles parked on Springfield Catholic High Schools' campus must be registered with the school office.
- 6. Parking tags must be hung from the rearview mirror. Failure to hang the parking tag may result in a fine.
- 7. Vehicles may be parked in authorized areas and in designated parking spaces only.
- 8. Vehicles must be operated in a safe manner. This includes but is not limited to state motor laws, namely: no speeding, no reckless driving, and no driving without a license. Speed on school grounds will not exceed 10 m.p.h.
- 9. Students are not permitted to go to cars during the school day. If a student needs to go to the car, you must receive permission from a teacher or an administrator. Students may not sit in parked cars during the school day.
- 10. Students may not sell or transfer a permit to another person. The permit posted in the front window of the vehicle must match the vehicle described on the registration form.
- 11. Students who begin to drive a different vehicle to school or receive new license plates will need to notify the school office of such changes.
- 12. In case of loss of parking permit, a student may purchase a replacement permit from the office for \$5.00.
- 13. Parking violations may result in fines or suspensions/forfeit of a parking permit.
- 14. All drivers must adhere to all posted traffic regulations. The road/drive entering the parking lot is one-way and the drive exiting the parking lot is one-way.
- 15. Students may not park or loiter in the parking lot after hours and after school activities.
